Senior High School Graduation Requirements

To graduate from high school, a student must successfully complete a minimum of 20 credits, five of which must be at the Grade Twelve level. Compulsory credits will include the following:

3 English credits, one of which must be English 621A or English 671A/C;

2 Math credits;

2 Science credits;

2 Social Studies credits, one of which must focus on Canadian social studies such as CAS 401A, CIV 421A, GEO 421A, LAW 521A, HIS 621A, HIS 621B, or POL 621A;

1 Physical Education credit designated as PED 401A;

1 Career Education and Personal Development credit designated as CEO 401A;

1 Credit from a designated list that fosters creativity or innovation (see the *Senior High Program of Studies and List of Authorized Materials* for list), or one of the following French courses: FRE 421A, FRE 421F, FRE 521A, FRE 521F, FRE 621A, or FRE 621F;

8 Elective Credits.
